Time For Change: Week 1 ~ Jeff Hoover

LUKE 8:22-25 ~ "Let's cross to the other side of the lake"

The Text: ²² One day Jesus said to his disciples, "Let's cross to the other side of the lake." So they got into a boat and started out. ²³ As they sailed across, Jesus settled down for a nap. But soon a fierce storm came down on the lake. The boat was filling with water, and they were in real danger. ²⁴ The disciples went and woke him up, shouting, "Master, Master, we're going to drown!" When Jesus woke up, he rebuked the wind and the raging waves. Suddenly the storm stopped and all was calm. ²⁵ Then he asked them, "Where is your faith?" The disciples were terrified and amazed. "Who is this man?" they asked each other. "When he gives a command, even the wind and waves obey him!" (Luke 8:22–25 NLT-SE)

· The Setting

- A lake...12 miles/6 miles/200 ft deep. The lake had many names depending upon who what referring to it. The wind often came up between 3pm and 7pm.
- A boat...13 men on a small boat and Jesus is sleeping.

· The People

- The crowd that was following Jesus...hundreds, maybe thousands of people; the curious, the hungry, the sick, the critics, and all sorts of random people who just wanted to be close to Jesus.
- The **disciples** (*methetes* "apprentice") who were being trained by their Rabbi...This is still the primary way of spiritual training employed.
- **Jesus**, who was preparing His disciples or apprentices with 3 goals in mind:
 - To *learn your rabbi's "yoke"* (his set of teachings)
 - To become like your rabbi, your end goal being to "be your rabbi"
 - To carry on your rabbi's work in the world ("Go, and make disciples...")

· The Message

- "We're going to the other side of the lake!"
- His authority over nature came from His role as Creator. The wind and the waves recognized His voice!
 - You rule the raging of the sea; when its waves rise, you still them. (Psa 89:9 ESV)
- "I have something I want you to see, hear, and learn. It's on the other side of the lake."

Question: Why did Jesus cross the lake? To get to the other side!

- When Jesus said let's go over to the other side of the lake, there was a bigger purpose. Were the life
 lessons learned on the trip valuable? Certainly, but the disciples were going to have a front row seat as they
 witnessed Jesus performing some incredible hands-on ministry with a demon-possessed man.
- When the boat touched shore, Jesus was immediately met by a man needing deliverance. He finished
 that project and immediately headed back across the lake to Galilee where he was greeted by the crowds he
 had left earlier.





- **Jesus**, the disciple's Rabbi, **took them across the lake for a reason**. He had a plan. He was about to reveal who He was in a most remarkable way.

- Strengthening Individuals...What can we do to bring the best out in people? How can we support each other as we pursue the destiny we have in God together? These are real questions that have real answers.
 - 8 Jesus Christ is the same yesterday, today, and forever. 9 So do not be attracted by strange, new ideas.
 Your strength comes from God's grace, not from rules about food, which don't help those who follow them. (Heb 13:8–9 NLT-SE)
 - I thank Christ Jesus our Lord, who has given me strength to do his work. He considered me trustworthy and appointed me to serve him, (1 Tim 1:12 NLT-SE)
- Strengthening Families...God is strengthening families and is asking us to join Him in this adventure. This
 isn't something we initiate, but we're asking for discernment to be able to see where He is bringing
 strengthening and cooperating with the Holy Spirit as He moves families towards wholeness.
 - The family is at the heart of God's purpose and design for humanity.
 - The Bible makes clear the **important role of family** precisely because it is the place where we are formed and mature and where we learn values and grow in faith.
- Strengthening Congregations...For the past 20 years, we have pursued breaking down walls between congregations and we're not stopping now! Evangel will continue to look for opportunities to build relationships with other congregations through shared ministry (TRiHOP, Love INC, School of the Spirit) and outreach (Community House, Caring Pregnancy Center and Emergency Support Shelter).
